19-20/0275 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr Warnes due to a work commitment.

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19-20/0278 BADDESLEY PARK FOOTBALL CLUB

The Chairman welcomed Mark Blake of Baddesley Park Football Club to the meeting.

Mark had attended to discuss the possibility of the club erecting signage on the outside fence surrounding the Recreation Ground. The club was currently looking at sponsorship and was seeking permission to include its sponsors' names on any permitted signage.

The Chairman asked for designs of the signage, including the sponsors' names, with dimensions and proposed locations. Cllr Knight suggested that Mark look on TVBC's website for guidance as the Parish Council would be restricted by their rules. The Parish Council agreed in principle to Mark's request.

Drainage at the former cricket field was also discussed. Works by Drainline to flush through underground pipes had been successful to a degree, but football matches had been postponed after heavy rainfall due to the field still being too wet for use. Mark suggested employing the services of a specialist company to look at drainage and quality of the soil. The FA could then be approached for a grant to carry out the works. Cost of a specialist survey would cost £1300 and Mark suggested that this be split 50/50 between the club and the Parish Council. Cllr Middlewick suggested the club apply for a Borough Councillor grant. Mark agreed to send the quotation to the Clerk which would provide a breakdown of the work involved.

The groundsman had undertaken the first couple of slitting processes to improve drainage on the field and the possibility of sanding was discussed. This would be costly and would be decided later if it was deemed necessary.

The Chairman thanked Mark for attending and he left the meeting.

BBC RADIO SOLENT

BBC Radio Solent had contacted the Clerk to seek permission to carry out a live broadcast of the service around the war memorial on Remembrance Sunday. The Parish Council agreed in principle but subject to the approval of the vicar. The organiser wanted to interview a local historian regarding the background to the names on the war memorial and also to interview local residents on what the service meant to them. If the live broadcast was approved by the vicar, the Clerk undertook to inform, in advance, as many of the groups attending the service as possible.
