**SCOUT HUT**

A key to the padlock on the barrier gate at Mountbatten Park had been cut for the Scouts. Cllr Knight undertook to deliver it. The Clerk undertook to liaise with the Scouts over the location of the recently purchased defibrillator.

**TREE IN TORNAY GROVE**

The Clerk had emailed TVBC Planning Department for help in getting a qualified Arboriculturist to carry out a technical report on the tree overhanging the back garden of 8 Tornay Grove. TVBC had been operating a reduced service due to Covid 19 but there had been no reply for some time. Cllr Warnes agreed to take up the matter with TVBC.

**20-21/0317 SPEED LIMIT REMINDER SIGNS**

After careful consideration of the quotations it was agreed that two solar powered speed limit reminder signs would be purchased plus a one-off Bluetooth Data Capture Function for both. Fixtures and fittings would also need to be purchased. The approximate cost would be £6,000 and, with a County Councillor grant of £1,500 from Cllr Alan Dowden, the cost to the Parish Council would be approximately £4,500. The Clerk undertook to contact HCC for permission to site the signs in various locations within the village.

**ACTION: The Clerk to order the sign, liaise with County Cllr Alan Dowden with regard to applying for the grant and contact HCC for permission to site the signs.**

**20-21/0318 HOE LANE**

Cllr Warnes thanked Cllr Wotton for liaising with Hoe Lane developers over irregularities in their consultation documents. The developers had agreed that, although the consultation period was due to end that evening, comments would still be considered.

**20-21/0319 METAL THEFT**

Cllr Knight reported that there had been several incidents of metal objects being taken from residents' back gardens without their permission. This had been reported via Facebook and Cllr Knight advised that residents should be made aware.
