#### The content of this programme.

#### Stage I

- s. 1. Finding your way how the keyboard is built, black keys and white keys, how to play it hands and pedal use.
- s. 2. Sounds within the keyboards exploring keyboard's sounds, playing simple melodies, using different sounds, individual and group exercises on a keyboard.
- s. 3. Over 18s playtime revision playing keyboard together in 'free improvisation', with changing sounds, in pairs, individually and with the whole group.

#### Stage II

- s. 4. Learning the musical alphabet, right hand and left hand, musical notation and what is it for, examples introduction part 1.
- s. 5. Learning to play by ear making music without notation introduction, learning how to do it part 1.
- s. 6. Over 18s playtime revision playing keyboards with musical notation or (and) by ear, in pairs, individually and with the whole group, finding your own preference.

#### Stage III

s. 7. Learning a musical alphabet, right hand and left hand, musical notation and what is it for, examples – introduction part 2.

Learning simple songs on a keyboard reading notes. Playing together or in pairs, preparing this way one or two simple pieces of music for a short show.

s. 8. Learning to play by ear - making music without notation – introduction, learning how to do it part 2.

You will undoubtedly be aware by now that the North Baddesley Parish Council, Recreation Ground Charity, and the North Baddesley Youth and Community Club, working with partners Kiwi Education Ltd and a host of local and regional professionals, is building the strongest possible employment support programme for people in North Baddesley.

Apprenticeships are not just for younger people; they are for all age groups.

To this end, 9 different Apprenticeship and Careers Awareness Workshops will take place for those 18 and older in 2022. This is an ongoing project so many more and different workshops will take place in the future to allow over 18s to see what choices are available

**Woodturning** is going to become a regular feature of the overall community programme in North Baddesley and of course there is an apprenticeship route to this facet also, of which this is just one.

#### MAX CAREY WOODTURNING TRUST

The programme has been developed in partnership with the Avon and Bristol Woodturners. A course manual is available.


Experienced tutors are on hand to advise throughout the period. On successful completion of the programme a 'Certificate of Excellence' is awarded.

#### WOODTURNING TRAINING COURSES IN BRISTOL

The Max Carey Woodturning Trust provides Structured Woodturning Courses for beginners new to woodturning through to more the experienced turner. The aim is to give the novice the basic woodturning

skills and then allow them to develop their natural talent to become artistically creative and proficient in the craft.

## 'APPRENTICESHIP' Style Course

A comprehensive foundation course, suitable for newcomers to woodturning, is offered over a 20-week period.

The course has been developed and regularly updated to provide a structured approach to developing basic woodturning and tool sharpening skills. A course manual is available.

Experienced tutors are on hand to advise throughout the period.

On successful completion of the course a 'Certificate of Excellence' is awarded.

#### JOURNEYMAN Course

This intermediate course is aimed at progressing, stretching, and challenging the more experienced turners.








The course encourages the turner to experiment with new techniques. Hollow forms, off-centre, carving, colouring, piercing and texturing are just some skills which can be developed.

A structured course manual and website material enable the turner to choose from a range of activities and projects which best suits their own personal development needs. Journeyman projects are shown here

#### **ARTISAN Course**

This advanced course is designed to challenge more experienced turners and increase their range of expertise and experience. These include latticework, thin wall turning, spirals, turning polyester resin and laminated materials, involuted turning, multi-centre turning, carving on the lathe, segmental work, piercing and several other methods for decorating turned work.

The course is run as a group to encourage interaction and learning from each other during the making of the different items.





#### **MASTERS Course**

The Masters course will enable the experienced turner to develop broader skills to further enhance the



craft of woodturning and the ability to encourage and support new entrants into the craft. This will be achieved through a structured course which will include, Creative Design, Personal Specialism, Instructor/Demonstrator Training and Health and Safety/First Aid Training.

The programme will complete the woodturners learning experience and provide the skills to promote and progress an individual's journey in woodturning.



The basic level of coaching does not provide a qualification for leading. A Level 1 is for an assistant coach, and this is the basic level. A L2, is where a coach can lead on sessions. However, it is advised, to have at least 2 years coaching experience before embarking on a L2; prerequisite for a level L2, also require a full 6 hour First aid course, a Safeguarding & Protecting Children workshop certificate and a DBS.

Start your coaching journey with our

England Netball Level 1 course, providing you as a learner with an introduction to coaching the game and working with players, from under 7 to open age. Following the completion of the course, you will be able to assist more qualified coaches in delivering aspects of coaching sessions.



England Netball Level 1 Course

Who is this course for?

Perfect for those who are at least 16 years of age, who wish to start coaching netball. You will need to have an understanding of the rules and a sound knowledge and experience of the game.

What will I need to do?



Attend all 3 virtual sessions of the designated course and the associated professional discussion. Please note that we do not allow learners to move from course to course

Have access to a computer and the internet to be able to access the virtual sessions and to access our e-portfolio assessment system.

Yes, for men too

We require learners to show an original form of photo ID to their assessor at the start of their professional discussion. This can be a passport, a driver's license, or an ID card. Failure to do this will prohibit you from taking your assessment and gaining your qualification
