
Become a Leader or Volunteer 'Communiteer' and make a difference.

Kiwi proactively approached a number of young people who were at the 21st of May Village Day event who looked like they could be around the age of 16+, also approaching those younger than 16 and over 16, including parents.

Some did take a leaflet and shared thoughts and ideas and asked relevant questions. Engagement also came from retired men, who joked about themselves being too old to be an Apprentice.

However, research into the term Apprentice tells us this.

'The definition of an apprentice is someone who provides help to a skilled worker in order to learn the trade themselves. An example of an apprentice would be **a person** who works with an electrician to learn the skills necessary to become a skilled electrician'. Apprentices are aged **16 or over** and combine working with studying to gain skills and knowledge in a specific job.

The common assumption is that Apprenticeships are for young people only, but this is definitely not so. In short, one can be an Apprentice at any age. As the term may stigmatise or embarrass older people away from such an opportunity, a change in term might be considered, Senior Apprentice, or simply Learner or Trainee perhaps – food for thought!

More success came from the interaction with other stalls such as the Scouts; a good Carpentry contact and the HOUNZ dog charity could be good links. A major success was via a link made with ICAAL, the largest Digital Marketing company across the South of England. Kiwi has already had a meeting with them and have secured agreement for several Traingeship placements and x2.



them and have secured agreement for several Traineeship placements and x2 Digital Marketing Apprenticeships.

Marketing was done via Linkedin/FB/Instagram and Kiwi's own webpages. It was shared via about 15 FB groups in and around NB/Romsey etc.: also, via Mountbatten School and Eastleigh College. In addition, Kiwi has regular contact with the Careers Adviser at Mountbatten School and local Colleges.



If there is buy-in from 12 definitely confirmed attendees, Kiwi would put on a series of careers Guidance Workshops in the Pavilion on the Recreation Ground, an Autumn start might be useful.

Kiwi is a real boon to the North Baddesley community so regular updates about opportunities will be provided in Bulletins.
