## NORTH BADDESLEY PARISH COUNCIL GRANT AWARDING POLICY

This policy was adopted by the Parish Council at their AGM on 18<sup>th</sup> May 2015 and is reviewed annually.

## **Procedure**

- Grants will only be accepted for consideration if the Parish Council's application form has been completed and supporting documentation provided.
- 2 Grant applications will be considered at full council meetings and must be submitted to the Clerk at least 7 working days before that meeting. A calendar of meetings can be obtained from the Clerk or viewed on the website: <a href="www.northbaddesley-pc.gov.uk">www.northbaddesley-pc.gov.uk</a>.
- Applicants will be notified within 7 days of the full council meeting whether their application has been successful.
- 4 Applicants must be prepared to attend the meeting, if requested to do so, to answer questions.
- Grant recipients may be required to provide evidence of purchase or a report on the project within one month of receiving the grant.

## Criteria

- Grants will only be made to organisations within the parish unless there are direct benefits to the parish.
- 7 The Parish Council has an annual grant budget which it will not exceed. Therefore grants may be reduced in size according to the number of applicants.
- 8 Grants will be from £50 to £500. They will be one-off payments and will not be considered once a project has commenced.
- 9 Application forms must be received by the Clerk at least 7 working days before the meeting.
- Applicants may be required to produce evidence of other sources of fund-raising or grants from other organisations towards the project.
- Only one application can be made for each project, but more than one application can be
  - made for different projects in any one financial year.
